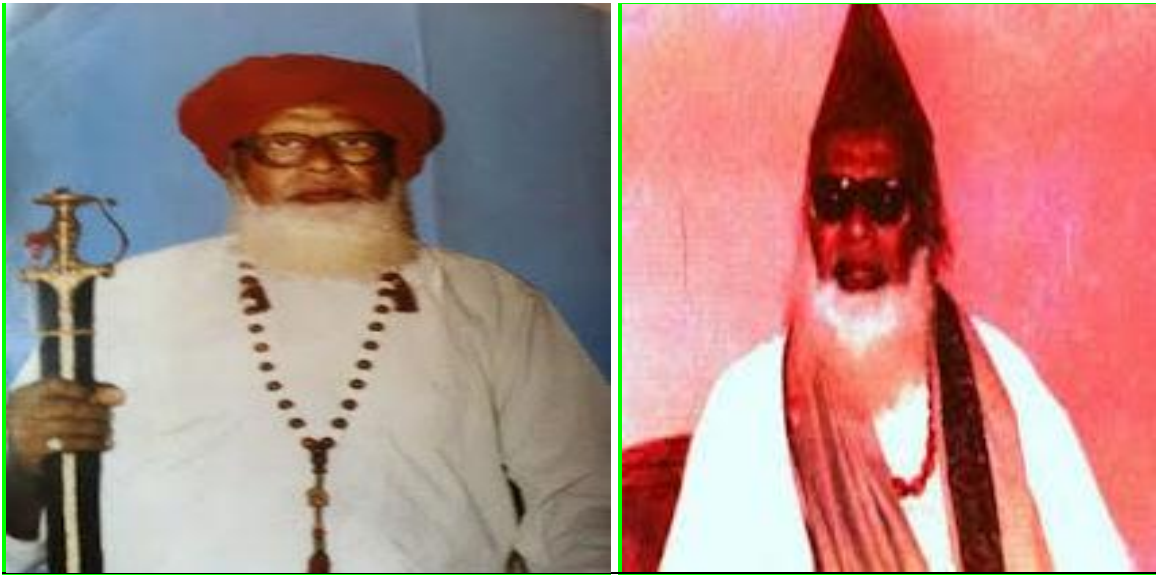

Noorishah Jeelani (r.z) was a renowned Muslim Sufi, saint and scholar of the Qadri, Chisti order from Indian sub continent. He was the 21st grand son of Ghousul Azam Sheikh Mohiyudheen Abdul Qadir Jilani. He is popularly known as "Noorul Mashaikh". His Silsila has spread through the world more than 40 countries with millions of Mureeds, several Khanqahs, masjids and madrassas. He is the Founder of Kerala's First Islamic Arabic College Jami'a Nooriyya Arabic College, Pattikkad in Malappuram District. He was the student (mureed) of the renowned Sufi saint Alhaj Moulana Peer Ghousi Shah. Finally he received the khilafat and wirasat from his shaiikh Kanzul Irfan Hazrath Moulana Sheikh Ghousi shah.

His mausoleum (Darga Shareef) is located in the Bandlaguda area of [Hyderabad](#), India.
